In 2018, the World Economic Forum is hosting its annual ASEAN summit in Ha Noi from 11 to 13 September under the theme “ASEAN 4.0: Entrepreneurship and the Fourth Industrial Revolution”.

In ASEAN, the labour force is forecast to expand by 11,000 workers every day for the next 15 years. And yet, industrial robots now out-compete low-skilled manufacturing labour; artificial intelligence threatens ASEAN’s service jobs; and self-driving vehicles are already at work in South-East Asia. How will the youth of the region find work and stay ahead of these technological disruptions?

One critical part of the answer lies in entrepreneurship, and building new companies and future-focused economies and societies. Given that ASEAN youth will never know a time before the Fourth Industrial Revolution, how do we ensure that the potential offered by start-ups and entrepreneurship will create a brighter future for everyone?

The Open Forum is a special public-facing part of the ASEAN summit, designed to share key ideas and involve the wider community in important discussions. This session has been designed to offer today’s students and the general public an opportunity to discuss what their future might look like as technological disruption shapes ASEAN 4.0. Join a special panel of inspirational entrepreneurs and thinkers to debate the critical issues around an “ASEAN 4.0 for all”.
